OAA Commissioner Responsibilities

All OAA commissioners would have the same minimal job tasks. These would include:

1. Annually assign approved officials for all ninth, junior varsity, and varsity contests (where appropriate).
2. Assign replacement officials to contests when the original official can not attend the contest.
3. Annually provide two in service meetings for all roster officials for their specific sport. One in service must occur prior to the start of the sport season. The OAA sport committee must approve the agenda for the in service prior to implementing the program. The purpose of the in service program is to improve the quality of officiating in the association.
4. Annually institute a system for evaluating all OAA roster officials of the sport. The system must include input from the coaches, review by the sport committee and ultimate approval of all officials by name by the athletic directors as a whole.
5. Annually the commissioner shall recruit at least 10% new officials for the OAA in the given sport. These new and/or limited experience officials will be provided in service training and a schedule of ninth and/or junior varsity athletic contests to officiate.

The Oakland Activities Association will hire commissioners to assign, evaluate, and provide in service training in the following sports:

Football - Ninth Grade, Junior Varsity, and Varsity. Salary: **\$3500**

Soccer - Ninth Grade, Junior Varsity, and Varsity. Salary: **\$3500**

Basketball - Ninth Grade, Junior Varsity, and Varsity. Salary: **\$5600**

Volleyball - Ninth Grade, Junior Varsity, and Varsity. Salary: **\$1680**

Wrestling - Junior Varsity and Varsity. Salary: **\$1120**

Swimming - Varsity and Association Meets. Salary: **\$800**

Gymnastics - Instituted in 1997-98. Varsity and all association meets.
Salary: **\$600**
