

**Oakland Activities Association
Basketball Guidelines**

1. All O.A.A member schools must abide by State and National rules governing High School Basketball
2. All O.A.A. member schools must provide all opposing O.A.A. member schools with rosters for both JV and Varsity teams (also Freshman if possible). Roster should include name, uniform number, height and grade. Roster should be received before the first O.A.A. contest, league or division game.
3. All O.A.A. member schools must provide water and basketballs to visiting O.A.A. member schools at the Frosh, JV and Varsity levels.
4. All O.A.A. member schools must provide visiting O.A.A. member schools with a white board in the varsity locker room.
5. All O.A.A. member schools must have the floor swept before and at halftime of JV and Varsity games.
6. Warm-up time shall be 15 minutes minimum, 20 minutes maximum. The visiting team shall decide. Officials do not decide warm up time.
7. All O.A.A. host schools must call the Detroit News, Detroit Free Press and Oakland Press with final scores and results following varsity contests.
8. Pre-Game Introduction:
 - Players are introduced alternately, visitors first.
 - When introduced players are not to go shake hands of opposing coach.
 - After being introduced, players must go to center circle shake hands with adjacent player, then go to foul line across from the team bench.
 - There is to be no ceremony by either team at center circle.
 - Remainder of team may join in at free throw line only.
